

5 Criteria regarding the provisions of Article 60, Paragraph 2 of the University Regulations and the provisions of Article 28, Paragraph 9 of the Graduate School Regulations

Ruling by the President

The “Situations Recognized as Special Circumstances by the President” stipulated in the proviso of Article 60, Paragraph 2 of the University Regulations and the proviso of Article 28, Paragraph 9 of the Graduate School Regulations shall be as follows.

1. Applicable students

- (1) Students who have taken a leave of absence in accordance with Article 62, Paragraph 2 of the University Regulations or Article 33, Paragraph 2 of the Graduate School Regulations, and whose reason for the leave of absence is due to an infectious disease as specified in Article 18 of the Ordinance of Enforcement of the School Health and Safety Act.
- (2) Students who have taken a leave of absence in accordance with Article 62, Paragraph 2 of the University Regulations or Article 33, Paragraph 2 of the Graduate School Regulations, and whose reason for the leave of absence is judged by the President to be equal to or greater than those in the preceding Item.

2. Procedures

(1) Application

Students who have been on leave of absence in accordance with Article 62, Paragraph 2 of the University Regulations or Article 33, Paragraph 2 of the Graduate School Regulations and wish to graduate early or complete the program with a shortened period of enrollment must apply to the Dean of College or Graduate School through their department chairperson within the period of procedures for early graduation or completion with a shortened period of enrollment as specified by each department.

(2) Notification

(1) In the case of 1 (1) above

The President shall confirm the request and notify the Dean of College or Graduate School of the decision.

(2) In the case of 1 (2) above

The President shall make a decision based on the request and notify the Dean of College or Graduate School of the decision.
